- Have practased law for bet ween 4 and 10 years on the date of application; Á

- Be currently working for a Brazilian, Mexican orÁ
   Colombian law tirm, and be supported by your " law tirm to participate in the programme;

• Have strong professional interest, and preferably experience, in international work.
